Immigration Exceptionalism

In immigration cases, the Supreme Court's normal rules of constitutional adjudication do not always apply. Should immigration law receive special constitutional treatment? Should it receive special treatment for some purposes (e.g., federalism) but not others (e.g., rights)?

As Professor David Rubenstein will explain, the transition between the Obama and Trump administrations crystallizes the stakes of these and related questions – both legally and politically.
